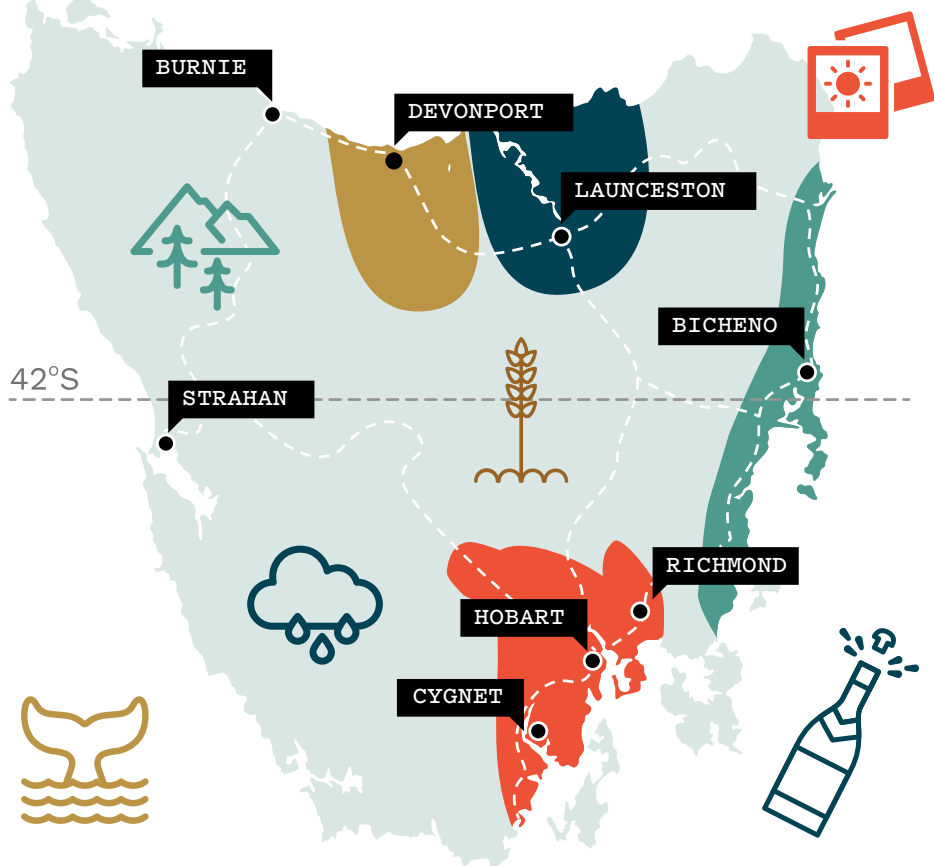

Visiting TASSIE



lutruwita / Tasmania (or Tassie, as the locals know it) is one of the most spectacular places in the world. Lush green corners of paradise, picture-perfect beaches, snow capped mountains, breathtaking forests, waterfalls and lakes – you'll find just about every kind of scenery across our landscape. Not to mention cute, cuddly and curious wildlife.

You'll quickly find that Tasmania's vineyards are generally not found on flat land but follow the curve of a valley. Rocky outcrops and windy hilltops challenge the hardest of vine roots and the most committed of grape growers. This makes for diverse and distinctive wines – ancient soils vary wildly from one side of the creek to the other and no two vineyards or vintages are the same. You'll be able to taste the flavours of the season in each glass.

From converted heritage stables to ultra-modern cellar doors, chat and kick the dirt with our wine producers to find out why they have chosen to grow grapes and make wine in these extreme conditions on the edge of the world.

Although Tasmania is classified as one wine region, vineyards stretch right across the island. In this guide the seven distinct growing areas are divided into four wine touring trails. All are within easy reach of major centres and are located along the journey to some of Tasmania's iconic attractions and experiences.

Don't forget ...

Tasmanian wine is also perfectly crafted to complement our island's produce, so find a world class view (there are plenty) and feast like a local. For some more culinary inspiration, see some of our favourite wine and food pairings on page 52.

IN ANY DIRECTION FROM THE CITY OF HOBART
ROADS LEAD THROUGH MEANDERING RIVER
VALLEYS - WINDING PAST APPLE ORCHARDS,
FARMYARDS, FISHING PORTS AND (OF COURSE)
VINEYARDS.

From the Huon Valley in the south to the Derwent Valley, grapes are grown along riverbanks, seaside inlets and hilltop slopes. To the north-east, the Coal River Valley surrounds the historic township of Richmond. From here, journey on toward the Tasman Peninsula where – just around the next headland – the untamed Southern Ocean becomes ever more wild.

Although Tassie is surrounded by water, nowhere feels more maritime than the south, where Hobart's waterfront docks house ships and icebreakers bound for icy southern waters. There's a little something for everyone in a place so compact that a few days will feel like a week. With short travel times between adventures, you can be atop *kunanyi* / Mount Wellington and swimming at a beach on the same day, cruising up the River Derwent and meeting a local artist in Salamanca on the very same afternoon.

Old meets new in the island's lively capital. Find cosy bars along cobbled laneways and modern art in convict-built sandstone warehouses. Wandering the streets of Hobart has a way of striking up a hunger – whether it's the chill in the air or the smell of the many bustling kitchens, it's difficult to be sure. This city is anything but ordinary.

Like elsewhere in Tassie, you'll be able to graze the region's produce from a roadside farm stall through to the tables of a world-class eatery. Growers and makers deliver everything from soft goat's cheese, smoked salmon and roadside stall apples to world class wine of extensive variety.

And beyond the city and vineyards, southern Tasmania is a region of diverse and wild beauty; sea cliffs, big ocean, rare rock formations, tranquil rivers, glacial tarns and alpine mountains at the southern edge of the world.

- Each Saturday Salamanca Place hosts Australia's best outdoor market – bargains and buskers, art and craft, food and wine, trash and treasure.
- Follow up on Sunday with the freshest Tassie produce at the Farm Gate Market – ranked among the world's best.
- Visit the pinnacle of spectacular *kunanyi* / Mt Wellington and see the entire city and its harbour below.
- Immerse yourself in the power of Port Arthur and *turrakana* / Tasman Peninsula, its convict buildings, gardens, tours and tales – an essential Tasmanian experience.
- Get back to nature – walk the Three Capes Track, take a ferry to Bruny Island, a boat tour in the wild southern sea or wander villages and inlets of Tasmania's South.
- Weave your way west through the Derwent Valley to national parks, waterfalls and world heritage wilderness.

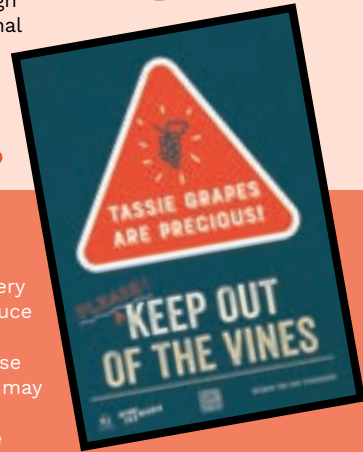

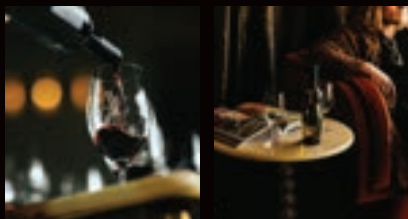

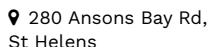

Exploration of Tasmania's northern wine growing areas is best done slowly – using Launceston as your base, begin with a pastry and good coffee (there is plenty on offer). However, be warned as you set out on your journey – you will need more than one day to visit all of the locations on your to-do list.

Tassie's north is home to the oldest and largest wine-growing area with a diverse range of cellar doors cosied up around *kanamaluka* / River Tamar.

The Tamar Valley Wine Trail stretches along both sides of this expansive waterway, which takes the area's water from dramatic beginnings at Cataract Gorge all the way to the open ocean of Bass Strait in the north.

From Evandale (south of the city) stop in on vineyards all the way up to Beaconsfield on the western side of the river, before crossing to the rolling hills of Pipers Brook in the east –

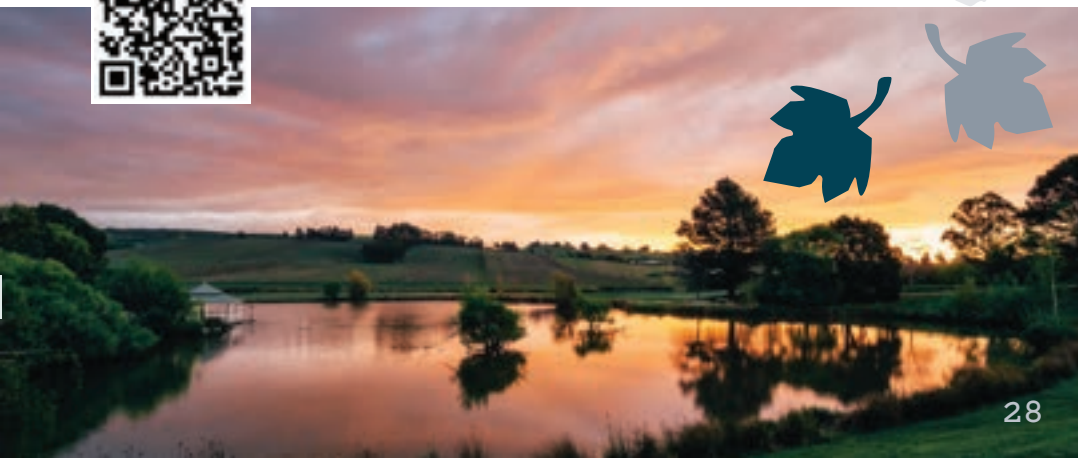
renowned for producing some of the world's most famous sparkling wine.

Along the way you will find an abundance of farm-fresh produce, vineyards, distilleries, cooking schools and dining experiences, making Tasmania's north an irresistible draw for lovers of good food and distinctive drinks.

This great food and excellent produce won't go to waste as you fuel up for your adventures. There's lots to see and do in the north.

Between wine tastings take a hike in a dramatic gorge, ride beneath towering ferns, sled a river or fly between tall trees. Shred mountain-bike trails, slip into a sauna, then plunge into a lake. Wander through a convict site and visit a museum. Or just relax at the end of the day and toast your good fortune (with a glass of local Pinot Noir, of course).

Some things to SEE & DO:

- Cataract Gorge is a rare natural phenomenon within a two-minute drive of central Launceston. With its rolling lawns, gardens, rotunda, swimming pool, footbridge and a chairlift across the river, not to mention the peacocks and wallabies – this may be Australia's most alluring urban reserve.
- Experience *lutruwita* / Tasmania's rich mining history at the Beaconsfield Mine and Heritage Centre.
- Visit Evandale, one of the best preserved late Georgian/early Victorian historic townships in

Australia or one of the nearby historic farming properties.

- Dine in style at one of Launceston's (many) excellent restaurants and wine bars. This is a UNESCO City of Gastronomy, after all.
- Take to the water and cruise the hidden reaches of the Tamar River and the Tamar wetlands – a haven for local birdlife.
- Taste the region's freshest produce and wines every Saturday at Launceston's Harvest Market in Cimitiere Street.

Abundant produce, clever makers and epic wilderness – a journey in the North West is a feast for the senses.

Tasmania's North West Wine Trail surrounds seaside towns along the edge of Bass Strait. This is the gateway to some of Tasmania's most popular wilderness destinations, where rich and fertile soils and rushing snowmelt rivers nourish an overflowing bowl of produce.

This region is known for everything from berries and vegetables to truffles and some of the island's most famous dairy products. Generosity and token dairy cows come standard. That's the simple, pure, time honoured recipe that awaits your visit.

Vineyards (and warm welcomes) can be found on a short diversion from the main route and as you

taste your way through the region it's time to eat up. Visit farm gate stalls, cellar doors and distilleries. Follow your food from paddock to plate (or glass) while meeting the farmers, growers, makers and beekeepers along the way.

And after you've done that, get wild. Explore rugged coastlines, ancient rainforests, tranquil rivers and mysterious caves. Stand on a cliff top and feel the force of the Roaring Forties.

Meander between charming seaside villages. Refresh on a windswept coast or rejuvenate on a mountain hike. Or simply pause and enjoy the stillness of the *takayna* / Tarkine forests. Breathe deeply and slowly – this is the cleanest air on the planet.
