With more than 200 vineyards around the island and an increasing global reputation for our wines, this is an exciting opportunity to be part of the dynamic Tasmanian wine sector.

A one day free specialised "how to pick" wine grapes training course is being offered by Wine Tasmania for 30 people in late March/early April in both North and South regions (specific dates to be advised closer to harvest).

Conducted in partnership with TasTAFE and the Tasmanian Government, the session will comprise detailed and practical training at two vineyard locations, giving you a chance to put what you have learned into practice by harvesting the very first grapes of the 2022 vintage!



All participants who display competency in the activity will receive a Certificate of Completion and with their details shared with Tasmanian wine producers and labour hire companies for potential employment during the upcoming 2022 vintage and beyond.
