The VinØ (“VinZero”) program has been developed to measure, improve and report on the management practices of Tasmanian wine producers across the island.



This program ensures that Tasmania’s hard-working grape growers are doing everything they can to produce very high-quality wine, without negative impacts on the environment or local community. VinØ members understand the connection with the land and people and recognise that we are custodians with a responsibility to the future prosperity of Tasmania.

The VinØ program focuses on the following key areas of vineyard and winery management:

- The health of our soils, on which we rely on for high-quality wine grapes
- Managing pest and disease pressures in an environmentally responsible manner
- Biodiversity, using natural flora and fauna to support land and vineyard health
- Measuring and minimising water use in vineyards
- Responsibly managing waste and recycling
- Looking after our valuable vineyard personnel, and the broader community
- Understanding the role that members play in biosecurity, with respect to the longevity of the sector
- Managing aspects in the winery to ensure efficiency, quality and responsibility



The VinØ program provides a framework on the world’s best possible practices across each of these critical areas. Tasmanian grape growers use this framework to monitor, measure, report, benchmark and constantly improve their practices.
